Lorenzo Gusinu was born on August 14, 1992, in Brescia. He began studying electric guitar at the age of 15, approaching the path with great passion and discipline. After his first lessons with guitarist Maurizio Viola, in 2009 he embarked on a professional path at the Modern Music Institute (MMI) in Gussago under the guidance of Francesco Fisogni, specializing in rock and metal.

He continued his studies with Alex Stornello, president of MMI, focusing on fusion and enriching his education through numerous masterclasses, private lessons, and clinics with guitar giants such as Kiko Loureiro, Tony MacAlpine, Michael Angelo Batio, Greg Howe, Steve Vai, and many others.

Lorenzo is now recognized as a versatile and virtuosic guitarist, active both as a teacher and performer, with a style that blends advanced technique, melodic taste, and modern sounds.
